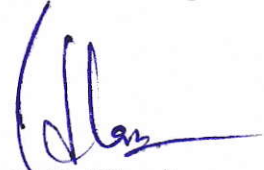

Subject:-Stakeholder Conference on the proposed Integrated Renewable Energy Policy of Jammu & Kashmir – reg.

1. The Jammu & Kashmir Energy Development Agency (JAKEDA), Science & Technology Department, Government of Jammu & Kashmir, in collaboration with Centre for Innovation and Transformation in Governance (CITaG) proposes to convene a Stakeholder Conference on the proposed Integrated Renewable Energy Policy – 2026 of Jammu & Kashmir with the objective of seeking views, suggestions and inputs from all relevant stakeholders for formulation of a comprehensive, investor-friendly and outcome-oriented policy framework for accelerating the transition towards clean and sustainable energy in the Union Territory.
2. The proposed Integrated Renewable Energy Policy is envisaged to provide a unified policy framework covering various renewable energy resources and technologies, including Solar, Wind, BESS & Hybrid Systems for promoting energy storage, electric mobility and integration of renewable energy with the existing power system.
3. The Stakeholder Conference shall provide an appropriate platform for detailed deliberations on the following key areas:
 - * Assessment and optimal utilisation of Jammu & Kashmir's renewable energy potential;
 - * Promotion of grid-connected and off-grid renewable energy projects;
 - * Rooftop solarisation and solarisation of Government buildings;
 - * Development of utility-scale and distributed renewable energy projects;
 - * Renewable energy in the agriculture sector, including solar pumps;
 - * Battery energy storage and other energy-storage solutions;
 - * Development of renewable energy parks and model renewable energy villages;
 - * Private sector investment, PPP and ESCO-based models;
 - * Single-window clearances and ease of doing business;
 - * Land, transmission, connectivity and evacuation-related issues;
 - * Fiscal and financial incentives for renewable energy projects;
 - * Skill development, employment generation and participation of local youth;

- * Research, innovation and technology development; and
- * Institutional, regulatory and implementation mechanisms for achieving the UT's long-term clean-energy objectives.

4. **Participation:** Representatives from the following stakeholder groups are proposed to participate in the Conference:
 - (i) Renewable energy developers, manufacturers, EPC companies and service providers;
 - (ii) Financial institutions, banks and investors;
 - (iii) Industry associations, chambers of commerce and business organisations;
 - (iv) Start-ups and technology providers working in renewable energy, storage and allied sectors;
 - (v) Other experts and stakeholders having relevant experience in the renewable energy sector.
5. The Conference is proposed to be held on **02.09.2026 at 3.30 P.M.** at **JAKEDA Office, Channi Rama, Near Traffic Headquarter, Jammu.** The detailed Policy is uploaded on JAKEDA website vis-à-vis www.jakeda.jk.gov.in.
6. All participating stakeholders are requested to submit their suggestions/recommendations on the proposed Integrated Renewable Energy Policy, preferably in advance.
7. The Executive Engineer, JAKEDA, shall coordinate the arrangements for the Conference and compile the suggestions/inputs received from stakeholders for consideration in the formulation of the final Integrated Renewable Energy Policy.
8. The Conference is expected to facilitate a broad-based consultative process and help formulate a comprehensive, progressive, sustainable and investment-friendly Integrated Renewable Energy Policy for Jammu & Kashmir, aligned with the UT's clean-energy transition objectives and the national goal of achieving a sustainable and low-carbon energy future.
